The proverbial lightness of the range is apparent in the PuraVida bathroom furniture: the semi-high cabinet (4) appears to float freely in front of the wall. This weightlessness is underlined by the soft curve of the recessed handles with their "flash" of colour that is the same colour as the respective surface combination, as in the vanity unit for the console basin (3) or furniture washbasin (2). The new furniture handrinse basin with vanity unit is a smaller solution (1).

A confident statement: The free-standing PuraVida bath (large illustration) features simple, uninterrupted lines. Alternatively, it is also available with rectangular acrylic panelling and integrated strip light, which offers a discreet flash of the respective furniture colour, or with a soft shimmering LED light – a subtle and contemporary luxury (illustration below). The washbasin and vanity unit also cut a fine figure as a simple square. The unusual feature is that the tap fitting sits directly in the basin. The chic mirror boasts a characteristic light square – it is available in three widths (top left). The beautifully shaped urinal with cover (left) or without cover is a practical and hygienic option that is also suitable for the private bathroom.



This variant offers lots of room for two and has two square console basins (47 x 47 cm) on one vanity unit. The generous surrounds around the basins hold all kinds of bathroom utensils. The oak real wood surface offers an attractive contrast to the brilliant white of the ceramic. The 170-cm high tall cabinet and a rectangular panelled bathtub complete the ensemble (small image).





A true Starck, but less elaborate: this was the inspiration behind the second Duravit – Philippe Starck collaboration. The result: **Starck 2**, a range of ceramics that is the ultimate successor to its famous predecessor, Starck 1. Starck 2 also derives its inspiration from the origins of bathroom design: the ceramic forms embody the flowing movement of water and allow us to see the bathroom through a new set of eyes. The Starck-2 console basin combined with a Starck vanity unit in high-gloss white is as elegant as it is practical (right). The doors of the mirror cabinet (small image on the right) open at the outer edge by 180°. The doors conceal a spacious interior. Useful light for everyday bathroom life. The topic of "light in the bathroom" is a common feature of all Duravit product areas. Starting with the extensive range of mirrors and mirror cabinets featuring intelligently integrated lighting elements that prove extremely helpful on an everyday basis, also with cosmetic tasks. The translucent glass shelf in the Fogo mirror cabinet (image bottom left) illuminates the content and area around the cabinet with an indirect, pleasant light. The clip-on light is a practical feature during facial-care routines.

(1) Mirror from the Starck programme with softly illuminated light square. (2) The clip-on light of the Fogo mirror cabinet emits a no-glare light. (3) A one-off - the Starck mirror with four illuminated edges.





Illuminating, showing the way, creating atmosphere: light has a variety of different functions in the bathroom. Functional lighting ensures the right visibility for everyday activities, for example, when shaving or applying make-up. When it comes to lighting, the innovative Mirrorwall ensemble comprising mirror, light, bathroom furniture and washing area ensemble proves the perfect solution to all requirements (see also P. 80): a 500 lux clip-on lamp with specially developed reflecting "sail" provides perfect illumination of the face for those from 160 to 195 cm in height. In addition, two rotatable LED light columns light up the mirror perfectly and illuminate the room; the light shines exactly where it is needed. The columns can also be used for changing coloured light programmes. With Mirrorwall, the practical and energysaving night-light mode is ideal for lighting the way to the bathroom during the night without waking you up completely.


Atmospheric light promotes wellness. When used correctly, light and coloured light can contribute to relaxation and well-being and it is not without reason that they are a valuable part of some therapies. What could be more natural than to combine these beneficial properties with relaxing Duravit products? Underwater LEDs in bathtubs, whirltubs and pools are used to create a special atmosphere, and also as part of sophisticated coloured-light programmes. The Inipi sauna also basks in wonderful light, flooded in complete coloured-light scenarios.

### Tips for optimum bathroom lighting...

- \* Function and emotion: The lighting should meet two different requirements. 1. Give the eyes sufficient support for difficult visual tasks, for example during facial care. 2. Create a positive mood and atmosphere, for example so that the bathroom user has a pleasant start to the day or can de-stress whilst taking a relaxing bath in the evening.
- \* Optimum illumination: White functional light should illuminate the whole face – uniformly and without casting shadows or dazzling. Lights with approx. 500 lux are ideal; this also corresponds to optimum workplace illumination.
- Why night light? With a light brighter than 20 lux, the body enters waking mode. It is better to use a spe-cial LED night light that provides sufficient orientation and safety when it is dark without waking the body









# What fantastic furniture!



Three cheers for craftmanship. Technologically-advanced features are certainly coveted when it comes to new bathroom furniture. What makes Duravit products unique, though, is the fact that all finishing touches on these pieces are performed by hand. The care that Duravit applies to the manufacture of its products is also reflected in the ongoing, meticulous quality controls that are carried out both during and after completion of all manufacturing stages, including: inspection of incoming goods, production, final inspection, functional testing.



Precision work. It's important that furniture subjected to great wear and tear is made with the highest precision. In a damp environment like the bathroom, every millimeter counts. Duravit bathroom furniture is characterized by high precision and careful craftsmanship. A defined miter joint (the right-angled connection between two parts) significantly increases the stability of the furniture. The use of a special adhesive protects against water.



A unified whole. The undercounter washbasins from the Architec, Santosa, Starck 3 and Vero ranges are inserted into the Duravit wooden console from below. An innovative technology allows ceramic and wood to be bonded without jointing – a transition that both looks and feels seamless. As there are no joints it is easy to clean.



It's like magic! Everyone knows what it feels like when your hands are wet – or even worse, dirty – and you have to switch on the light. This is no longer an issue thanks to the Duravit mirror with integrated lighting. Specially-developed for use in the bathroom, the mirror with integrated lighting features a sensor control that activates the light when it detects hand movement. A fantastic idea: light controlled like magic – and no more dirty light switches. Mirrors/mirror cabinets with sensor control are available for the 2nd floor and Fogo ranges.



Please handle with care. We think that life is loud enough. Inside the cabinets, illuminated glass shelves (e.g. with Fogo) or fluorescent tubes also ensure good, non-glare lighting.



Everything in its place! Fully extendible and removable without tools, the drawers in Duravit bathroom furniture not only enable the user to make maximum use of their interiors, they also facilitate cleaning. Many pieces of furniture from the 2nd floor, Fogo, Happy D. and X-Large ranges come standard with interior drawers that feature clever plastic box compartments and individually adjustable glass divisions. This creates more space, provides added practicality and allows for easy maintenance.



As if asleep. There's no getting around the fact that some of us have to get out of bed during the night to answer the call of nature. However, one thing we can control during those wee small hours is the amount of light we use to illuminate our path to the bathroom.
